

Using Email in Communication with my Provider

- **Q: Using email is so easy and saves time. When can I use it in communication with my provider?**
- A: Regular emails are as confidential as a post card, which means that others can get access to its content. **Therefore, regular email is not private nor confidential.** If you are NOT concerned about others potentially knowing that you receive care by me, **you may use regular email for SCHEDULING.** Otherwise, please use the phone or secure messaging. Occasionally, email addresses are mistyped, possibly resulting in your personal information unintentionally getting into the hands of others.
- A: I typically respond to emails within TWO business DAYS. **If you have an urgent matter, you will need to use the phone to obtain a timely response. EMAIL IS NOT APPROPRIATE FOR ANY TYPE OF EMERGENCY!**
- A: On occasion information can be lost due to technical failure. If you have not received an answer within two business days, please contact your provider by phone!
- **Q: I sometimes have just a short question for my provider, such as about medication side effects. Can I use email for that?**
- **A: The best and most confidential way to ask a short clinical question electronically is to use the CAREPATHS PATIENT PORTAL,** which you can access with the green button on the welcome page of www.FraukeSchaeferMD.com . You will receive a response within two business days or earlier. A link to an encrypted message will be sent to your email account on record, which you can click to access the answer provided.
- **A: More complex clinical issues and anything that cannot be answered in a short email needs to be discussed in a session.** If your concern is urgent, make sure to request an ASAP appointment with your provider!
- **Q: How can I access the CAREPATHS PATIENT PORTAL?**
